

THE HILLEL EFFECT

What happens when you survey over 13,000 students from 79 campuses across the United States? We can hold their demographic and Jewish background information constant and learn OUR impact on their Jewish identity and involvement!

This survey, conducted in February 2016, measured ASU Hillel's "effect" in four impact areas: (1) Appreciating Judaism's Centrality in Life; (2) Growing Knowledge and Connection to Jewish Life; (3) Having Strong Jewish Social Networks; and (4) Engaging with Israel.

ASU Hillel has a larger effect than the national aggregate on every measure!
